Two suspects sought in connection with early-morning robbery

Pair of men allegedly pulled victim from vehicle and struck him multiple times

ARKANSAS CITY, Kan. (January 19, 2016) — The Arkansas City Police Department is seeking two suspects in connection with a robbery early Saturday morning in eastern Arkansas City.

A 61-year-old Arkansas City man reported around 2:30 a.m. Saturday that he had been the victim of robbery in the 500 block of North E Street, near the BNSF Railroad tracks.

He said he was sitting in his vehicle when two unknown men approached him and pulled him from his vehicle. They then struck the victim multiple times in the head and face, causing injuries.

During that attack, the suspects took an undetermined amount of cash from the victim and they fled the scene afterward. The victim's injuries were evaluated by the Arkansas City Fire-EMS Department.

Police are continuing to follow up on information that might lead to the identification of the two suspects. Anyone with information regarding this incident is asked to call police at (620) 441-4444.

Those wishing to remain anonymous may contact Cowley County Crime Stoppers, which offers rewards of up to \$2,000 for information leading to an arrest.
